Weatherhead for International Affairs (WCFA) Pre and Mid-Dissertation Grants

Pre-dissertation grants are available to doctoral students who are in the early stages of dissertation research, that is, who are exploring or beginning to launch a project.

Mid-dissertation grants are available for doctoral students who have been conducting dissertation research and are midway in the process of completing their dissertations, but who have not yet reached the final year of completion.

Application Deadline: Typically early February on CARAT
